Programme and course outcomes for all Programmes offered by the institution are stated and displayed on website and communicated to teachers and students.

Response: The College offers a number of courses/programmes, both at undergraduate and postgraduate levels under the affiliation of West Bengal State University. The college uses different mechanisms and practices to communicate Programme outcomes and Course outcomes to all stakeholders.
