
#### 4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

#### Initiatives taken as per the Students' Feedback

Despite of the insufficiency of Teachers in different departments, the college is providing maximum no. of classes to each of the teachers so that the syllebus may be covered in due time.

Some of the teachers already provide notes & suggestions to the students before their exam. Other teachers are requested to provide these for the sake of the students.

The college has no liberty to appoint teachers either permanent or contractual, although the college has requested the higher authority for the same.
