

UG ONLINE ADMISSION ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA–2026-27

FOR FIRST SEMESTER of U.G.COURSES UNDER NATIONAL EDUCATION POLICY,2020 IN THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2026-27

The College offers **4-year Undergraduate Programs (Honours/Honours with Research) and 3-year Multidisciplinary Undergraduate Programs in Arts, Commerce and Science** under **Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes (CCFUG) based on National Education Policy, 2020** during the academic session **2026-27 under West Bengal State University**. The duration of the UG Programme (Honours/ Honours with research) is 4 years or 8 semesters and UG Programme (Multidisciplinary) 3years or 6 semesters.

Students who desire to undergo a 3-year UG Programme will be allowed to exit after completion of the 3rd year. Students may be permitted to take a break from the study during the period of study but the total duration for completing the Programme shall not exceed 7 years. The duration for Multidisciplinary UG Programme is 3 years, provided the student has completed all requirements to become eligible for appearing the University Examinations as per rules and syllabus pattern of **West Bengal State University** to which the College is affiliated.

Eligibility Criteria for:

- **Admission in First Semester of the Eight Semester (4-year) Undergraduate Programs in B.A. Bengali/B.Com.(Honours/Honours with Research) under NEP and**
 - **Admission in First Semester of the Eight Semester (4-year) Undergraduate Programs in B.A./B.Sc (Honours) under NEP and**
 - **Admission in First Semester of the Six Semester (3-year) Multidisciplinary Undergraduate Programs in B.A./B.Sc. /B.Com. under NEP**
1. **A candidate, who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination or its equivalent from the All-India Boards / Councils or State Boards/ Councils including Open Schools and Vocational Studies, AND**
 2. **Passed in English having full marks of 100 (as per University Rules), AND**
 3. **Passed the previous qualifying examination on or after 2022 for Honours/Honours Research.**
 4. **Passed the previous qualifying examination on or after 2022 for Multidisciplinary programme.**
 5. For the purpose of determining eligibility for admission of the **4-year Honours Course**, aggregate marks shall be calculated **by adding the marks of top four subjects** in order of marks secured by a candidate. However, marks in **compulsory Environmental Education/Studies shall not be taken into account** for calculation of aggregate marks. If the subject “Environmental Science” is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.
 6. For the purpose of determining eligibility for admission to the **3-year Multidisciplinary UG programme of study**, aggregate marks shall be calculated **by adding the marks of top four subjects in order of marks secured by a candidate**. However, **marks in compulsory Environmental Education/Studies shall not be taken into account** for calculation of aggregate marks. If the subject “Environmental Science” is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.

N.B.: Admission to the Under Graduate Courses is strictly based on the Merit. All the process of UG Admission is strictly guided by the rules and regulations of West Bengal Higher Education Council’s, Higher Education Department, Govt. of WB and West Bengal State University.
